Photographs will be as follows.

1. Shows the used condom lying on the ground
2. The package the condom came in
3. A brown bottle and the table leg
4. The Budweiser beer can
5. The Coors beer can
6. An overall view showing the wooded area in which the above items were found
7. A cut mark on a tree
8. Also shows cut marks on the tree from different angle

Photographs were placed in a Special Investigator's envelope and turned in to the ID locker for processing.
